This 2½ day course begins at 8:00AM June 6, 2017 and ends on June 8, 2017 at 12:00PM. Class size is limited to 35 students: 25 slots for State Inspectors and 10 slots available to the Montana feed industry on a first come-first serve basis, limited to 1 person per facility. We will maintain a standby list to fill any cancellations.

The Current Good Manufacturing Practice, Hazard Analysis, and Risk-based Preventive Controls for Animal Food regulation (referred to as *the Preventive Controls for Animal Food* regulation) is intended to ensure safe manufacturing/processing, packing and holding of food products in the United States. The regulation requires that certain activities must be completed by a “preventive controls qualified individual” who has “successfully completed training in the development and application of risk-based preventive controls, or is otherwise qualified through job experience to develop and apply a food safety system”. This course developed by the FSPCA is the “standardized curriculum” recognized by FDA; successfully completing this course is one way to meet the requirements for a “preventive controls qualified individual.”

This course is taught by Lead Instructors trained by the FSPCA, who have been instructed in how to teach the FDA-recognized standardized curriculum.

It is up to each individual to make their own hotel room reservations. To make a room reservation please call (406) 443- 2100. Use Montana Department of Agriculture as the name of the event to receive the group rate. **All reservations must be received by May 6, 2017.**

Occupancy Rates per night: Single Occupancy \$95.00 - Double Occupancy \$111.00 (plus taxes). The hotel has a free 24 hour airport shuttle service available.

Lunch and breaks for 6/6 and 6/7 are included in the cost of registration.
