Colored maps from Google Maps are preferred.

- **Map size must not exceed 8 ½ X 11 inches** in size and must be large enough to be clearly understood.
- **Maps for large tracts of land** can be submitted in a manner that meets the requirements yet is logical for the producers.
- **Include farm** business name, county, site name, legal location description, and total acreage of site on the map.
- **Show the border, shape and size of the site.**
- **Identify locations** of crops and fallow land.
- **Indicate areas that separate your site from other land use** such as roads, canals, fences and open land.
- **Identify all adjacent land use**, including land managed by others.
- **Identify and label borders at risk of contamination** with prohibited materials.
- **Use the following symbols to indicate specific areas on the site map:**
