The Project

The Havre Community Garden Greenhouse Project is moving forward with support from the Montana Agritourism Grant Program and early guidance from Bear Paw Development's Food and Agriculture Development Center. The project will create a visible, public facing greenhouse space in Havre that connects people to local agriculture through hands on learning, seasonal growing, and community engagement rooted in the Hi Line.

Once completed, the greenhouse will support activities for children, seniors, and community members, as well as visitors who are curious about gardening and small-scale food production in a northern plains environment.

Planned uses include kid friendly planting days, senior gardening hours, informal workshops, and seasonal open house events that showcase local growing practices and the role of agriculture in daily life on the Hi Line.

By creating a place where people can experience how food is grown in this region, the project supports agritourism by increasing agricultural visibility, encouraging curiosity, and strengthening community pride in local food systems.

With early support from Bear Paw Development's Food and Agriculture Development Center and funding from the Montana Agritourism Grant Program, the greenhouse is becoming a shared space that invites people to learn, visit, and connect.
