Oswald Farms of Joliet, MT operates a generational ag operation that raises cattle and feeds them out to be processed at a local USDA plant. Owners, Melissa and Justin Oswald, sell their own branded beef products, Oswald Farms Beef, to local restaurants and direct to consumers through Facebook. They offer multiple beef products including specialty cut packaged meats, sausages, and snacks.
