The Project

Old Town Farmstand is a small family farm and retail food outlet in Three Forks, Montana. They produce farm-raised pastured poultry, baked goods from locally grown and milled wheat, and produce. Since their inception in 2023, they have started an onsite community market that features plant starts, arts, crafts and food products from other local producers. In addition to selling their own products and numerous farmers markets, they have a subscription farm box program, offer numerous on-site classes and have hosted agritourism based community events. By building a strong community network, they have not only increased the diversity of products offered to their customers, they are also providing a vital aggregation and access point for other producers to sell.

Old Town Farmstand has partnered with the RFBC via the MT Dept of Ag Food & Ag **Development Center at** Prospera in Bozeman. They have utilized the MT Dept of Ag Business Enhancement Program (BEP) to gain access to training focused on enhancing financial management skills in order to increase efficiency and accuracy in cash management to accurately evaluate the business' capacity and timing for a capital investment. The FADC/RFBC assisted Old Town in accessing a Business **Acceleration and Marketing** (BAM) grant to expand their line of pasture raised chicken through improved marketing and processing equipment to provide additional products.
