## \$25,250 GRANT USE / PURPOSE OF FUNDS

The GTA funds were used to build a production facility complete with cold storage. Prior to the construction of this new building, production capacity was limited. The new structure not only created a place for sorting vegetables and flowers, but the cold storage space made it possible for the farm to hold their products for a longer duration of time. These improvements significantly improved the farm's capacity and efficiency.

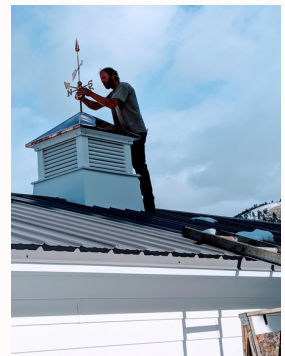
