The Annual Commercial Feed Tonnage Report is for reporting commercial feed and feed ingredients, including customer formula feeds, distributed in Montana. Feed ingredients are considered commercial feeds unless exempted by the definition of Commercial Feed, found at the bottom of this page. If a feed is fed to multiple species, report under the predominate species.

The supplier has primary responsibility for reporting and paying tonnage fees on commercial feed distributed **into** the state. However, the manufacturer is responsible for tonnage fees if the supplier has not paid them. The in-state guarantor or manufacturer is responsible for reporting and paying tonnage fees on commercial feed distributed **within** this state. Dealers, or those who only distribute commercial feed manufactured or guaranteed by another are **not required to file**, unless acting as a supplier. Manufacturers, guarantors, distributors, and suppliers of pet food or specialty pet foods **only are also exempt** from the reporting requirements.

This report is due no later than January 31 of each year setting forth the number of tons of commercial feeds distributed in this state during the preceding calendar year (January 1 through December 31). Each in-state guarantor or manufacturer who distributes commercial feed in this state and each supplier who distributes commercial feed into this state, upon filing the statement, shall pay the inspection fee of \$0.18 per ton.

The following form should only be used if you are required to submit and have not received a notice from the department. Complete the form and return with the appropriate fees to the address at the top of the form with check or money order payable to the Montana Department of Agriculture. Inspection fees which have not been remitted to the department on or before January 31 shall have a penalty fee of 10% with a minimum of \$25 added to the amount due.

If the 'Fees Due' equals \$5.00 or less, the Tonnage Fee is not due; simply enter zero in this box. However, Late Fees do apply for reports received after the deadline and must be paid.

DEFINITIONS:

COMMERCIAL FEED - means all materials or combinations of materials that are distributed or intended for distribution for use as feed or for mixing in feed, unless the materials are specifically excluded by law. Unmixed whole seeds and physically altered entire unmixed seeds, when those seeds are not chemically changed or adulterated within the meaning of 80-9-204, are exempt. Also exempt are commodities such as hay, straw, stover, fodder, silage, cobs, husks, hulls, raw meats and individual chemical compounds or substances when those commodities, compounds, or substances are not intermixed with other materials and are not adulterated within the meaning of 80-9-204.

DISTRIBUTE - means to offer for sale, sell, exchange, or barter commercial feed or to supply, furnish, or otherwise provide commercial feed to a contract feeder.

SUPPLIER – means a person who distributes commercial feed into Montana.
