## **PET and SPECIALTY PET FOOD REGISTRATION FORM**

The Montana Commercial Feeds Act Section 80-10-201 states “A person may not manufacture for distribution or distribute in this state a pet food or specialty pet food that has not been registered under this section by the manufacturer or the guarantor.”

Only pet and specialty pet foods are required to be registered; registration of commercial livestock feeds are not required. Registration is required once annually (January 1 thru December 31) by the manufacturer or on behalf of the manufacturer by the guarantor. Make check or money order payable to Montana Department of Agriculture. Send registrations to the address indicated at the top of the registration form.

Incomplete forms will be returned for completion. Allow up to three weeks for processing.

### **DEFINITIONS:**

COMMERCIAL FEED - means all materials or combinations of materials that are distributed or intended for distribution for use as feed or for mixing in feed, unless the materials are specifically excluded by law. Unmixed whole seeds and physically altered entire unmixed seeds, when those seeds are not chemically changed or adulterated within the meaning of 80-9-204, are exempt. Also exempt are commodities such as hay, straw, stover, fodder, silage, cobs, husks, hulls, raw meats and individual chemical compounds or substances when those commodities, compounds, or substances are not intermixed with other materials and are not adulterated within the meaning of 80-9-204.

GUARANTOR - “means a person whose name and principal mailing address appear on the label and who guarantees the information contained on the label as required by 80-9-202, MCA. The person may or may not also be the manufacturer.” (80-9-101, MCA)

PET FOOD - “means any commercial feed prepared and distributed for consumption by pets.” (80-9-101, MCA)  
THIS INCLUDES PET TREATS.

SPECIALTY PET FOOD – “means any commercial feed prepared and distributed for consumption by specialty pets such as any domesticated animal pet normally maintained in a cage or tank, including but not limited to gerbils, hamsters, canaries, psittacine birds, mynahs, finches, tropical fish, goldfish, snakes, and turtles.” (80-9-101, MCA)
