State Agency and County Weed District Biennial Noxious Weed Report FY 2012 and 2013

The purpose of this report is to summarize weed management information from biennial reports required from eight state agencies and 56 county weed districts. The report shows an estimated 365,458 acres of state lands are infested with noxious weeds and that 83,742 acres were controlled at a cost of \$5,488,734.00, for an average cost of \$65.54 per acre. However, at this rate, 11 percent of the weeds are being controlled per year but the weeds are increasing at a rate of approximately 14 percent per year. With this existing effort and budgeted amount the weeds will increase by 7,000 acres per the biennium. Additional funding is needed to control noxious weeds on state lands or we will continue to lose our most prized possession, our natural resources.

Under Section 7-22-2151, MCA, of the County Noxious Weed Control Act, state agencies are required to develop an agreement with county weed boards for weed management on state-owned lands. These agreements must include:

- an integrated noxious weed management plan that is updated biennially;
- a noxious weed management goals statement; and
- a specific plan of operations, including a budget to implement the plan.

An additional provision in this section requires a biennial performance report be submitted to the state weed coordinator at the Montana Department of Agriculture regarding the success of the plan on a form provided by the Department. A 2003 Legislative audit found the content of previous biennial reports inadequate to provide an assessment of effectiveness of each agency's weed program. To meet statutory requirements, an online reporting form was created for representatives of each agency and county to complete. Representatives must review and approve the report, then submit the report to the Department of Agriculture. <u>Comments included in the report are shown as written by the reporting agency and county representatives.</u>

It is critical for responsible parties at the local and state levels to communicate and actively take part in each other's program for weed management to be effective. One problem continuing to plague weed management in Montana is the lack of a stable structure. Each county and state agency needs a full-time weed coordinator with a line item budget dedicated for weed control. The Montana Weed Management Plan identifies county weed districts as being the cornerstone of Montana's weed program. One of the "action items" of the plan is to establish full-time weed coordinator positions in each county or multi-county area in Montana and in each state agency. Employing a full-time weed coordinator provides leadership that is critical for organizing, directing, and implementing weed management that will ultimately strengthen Montana's weed management effort and facilitate implementation of the Montana State Weed Management Plan.
